

February Updates

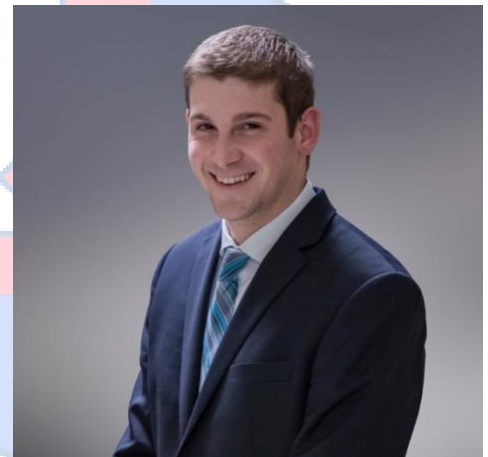
